- ⇒ At least a bachelor's degree & are licensed/ endorsed in each area they teach
- ⇒ Recruitment strategies and training ensure teachers are properly licensed and endorsed
- ⇒ Parents have a right to know about their child's teachers' qualifications

Parental Right to Information about Teachers

The Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) guarantees parents in Title I schools the right to request certain information about their child's teachers. The information that you have a right to request about your child's teacher is:

- ⇒ whether the teacher has met state qualifications and licensing criteria for the grade levels and subjects for which the teacher is responsible.
- ⇒ whether the teacher is teaching under emergency or other provisional status through which state qualifications for licensing have been waived.
- ⇒ the baccalaureate degree major of certification or degree held by the teacher, and the field of discipline of the certification or degree.
- ⇒ whether the student is provided services by paraprofessionals and, if so, their qualifications.
